

## **Proposed Goals for Executive Committee Approval Consideration**

SCDD Gathered Input from Self, Family and Community Advocates from 1-1-2015 to 12-31-2015. That input totaled more than 3,300 surveys. From those surveys, 6 areas were identified by the State Plan Committee for the Proposed Goals. Once these goals are approved by the Exec Comm, they will be posted for a 45-day public comment period on the SCDD website. After that 45-day public comment period, the objectives for each goal area can be finalized (they are currently in draft format). The Objectives do not require a 45-day public comment period. Once the Goals and Objectives are in final format from the State Plan Committee, Management and Staff will begin developing the Work Plan (which is the very specific tasks and timelines identified to successfully meet each objective).

### **Goal 1: Employment**

Californians with I/DD and their families reflecting the diversity of the state will ~~receive the necessary~~ have increased information and ~~supports~~ to ~~increase~~ obtain competitive, integrated employment.

### **Goal 2: Housing**

People with I/DD and their families reflecting the diversity of the state will have increased information to access ~~to~~ affordable, accessible, safe, and fully integrated housing that provides choice and flexibility regarding where and with whom they live.

### **Goal 3: Health and Safety**

Californians w/ I/DD and their families reflecting the diversity of the state will have increased information to access to health, public safety, and related services that meet their needs and health care choices.

### **Goal 4: Early Intervention & Education**

Californians with I/DD and their families reflecting the diversity of the state will have increased information, in order to obtain inclusive education services throughout the lifespan.

### **Goal 5: Formal & Informal Community Supports**

Californians with I/DD and their families reflecting the diversity of the state will have increased information and supports to access community-based services available to the general population.

### **Goal 6: Self-Advocacy**

Californians with I/DD and their families reflecting the diversity of the state will have ~~the~~ increased information and supports to advocate for civil and service rights to achieve self-determination, integration and inclusion in all areas of community life.
